

RESOLUTION NO. 21-R-02

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF MEADE, KANSAS REGARDING THE GOVERNING BODY'S INTENT TO LEVY A PROPERTY TAX EXCEEDING THE REVENUE NEUTRAL RATE:

WHEREAS, the Revenue Neutral Rate for the City of Fowler was calculated as 91.327 mills by the Meade County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, THE BUDGET PROPOSED BY THE Governing Body of the City of Fowler will require the levy of a property tax rate exceeding the Revenue Neutral Rate; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body intends to hold a hearing and hear testimony from all interested taxpayers desiring to be heard as required by state law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF Fowler:

Section 1. The Governing Body of the City of Fowler hereby sets a public hearing regarding its intention to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate for August 23, 2021, at 7:00 p.m. to be held at 508 Main Street in City Hall, Fowler Kansas and directs that notice of the public hearing be given as required by state law.

Section 2. The Governing Body of the City of Fowler expresses its intention to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate with a maximum mill levy of 91.727 mills.

Section 3. The Governing Body of the City of Fowler directs the City Clerk to provide this resolution to the Meade County Clerk as notice of the City's proposed intent to exceed the Revenue Neutral Rate.


This resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and shall remain in effect until future action is taken by the Governing Body.
